0619 – Application of proportionate ratchet charges to daily read sites https://www.gasgovernance.co.uk/0619	 No new issues were identified. Panel did not recommend 0619 was suitable for implementation by majority vote (5 out of 14 voted to recommend implementation). Panel did not specify a preference for this modification (4 out of 14 votes) over 0619A and 0619B. Awaiting Ofgem decision.
0619A – Protection from ratchet charges for daily read customers with an AQ of 73,200kWh and below https://www.gasgovernance.co.uk/0619	 No new issues were identified. Panel recommended 0619A was suitable for implementation by majority vote (9 out of 14 voted to recommend implementation). Panel did not specify a preference for this modification (7 out of 14 votes) over 0619 and 0619B. Awaiting Ofgem decision.
0619B – Application of proportionate ratchet charges to daily read sites https://www.gasgovernance.co.uk/0619	 No new issues were identified. Panel did not recommend 0619B was suitable for implementation by majority vote (5 out of 14 voted to recommend implementation). Panel did not specify a preference for this modification (1 out of 14 votes) over 0619 and 0619A. Awaiting Ofgem decision.

Pre-Modifications

- o Requiring a Meter Reading following a change of Local Distribution Zone or Exit Zone.
- The Workgroup noted the proposals and agreed that the modification should be raised for the April Panel.
- 0641S Amendments to Modification 0431 Shipper/Transporter Meter Point Portfolio Reconciliation rules and obligations. The Workgroup reviewed the amended modification, and concluded the Workgroup Report for submission to April Panel.

- 0649S Update to UNC to formalise the Data Enquiry Service Permissions Matrix. The
 Modification was reviewed by the Workgroup with the initial discussions focusing on what was
 the most appropriate governance route for the Modification, with consideration over whether or
 not it falls under the UNC Governance or via the DSC arrangements. These aspects will be
 considered further at the next meeting.
- **0651** Replacement of the Retrospective Data Update provisions. The Modification was reviewed by the Workgroup and it was noted that there was a concern around the indicative implementation timeline. It was agreed that interactions with the DSC arrangements should be considered and that the Modifictaion should be assessed further at the next meeting
- **0652** Obligation to submit reads and data for winter consumption calculation (meters in EUC bands 3 8). The Workgroup considered the Modification and agreed that it would be beneficial if it were developed alongside UNC Modification 0644 (and indirectly DESC) as part of the UIG Workgroup.

Other Workgroups

- 0630R Review of the consequential changes required in UNC as a result of the Ofgem Switching Programme. No meetings took place in March and the next meeting is 27 April 2018.
- **0639R** Review of AUGE Framework and Arrangements. No meetings took place in March and the next meeting is on 02 May 2018. It is anticipated that this meeting will firm up the proposals from the review and complete the workgroup report for submission to the May Panel.

- **Project CLoCC** (Customer Low Cost Connections) is focussing on customer low cost connections to the NTS:
- 0628S Standard Design Connections: PARCA process (Proposer National Grid NTS). The

 be requested to ensure the Modification and Legal Text align.
- 0629S Standard Design Connections: A20 connection process (Proposer National Grid NTS).
 The Workgroup reviewed the draft Legal Text and agreed that an extension to the June Panel should be requested to ensure the Modification and Legal Text align.

- The March 2018 DN Revenue reports were reviewed at the DNCMF on 27 March 2018.

- 0621 Amendments to Gas Transmission Charging Regime
 - Workgroup 0621 has been extremely busy assessing the impact of the 10 Modifications and continues to analyse the effects the changes would have on gas charges. Workgroup meetings have been frequent and will be significantly more frequent going forward, aiming for submission to the May UNC Panel. This is a deadline directed by Ofgem in its decision letter from 08 March (see here:

• **0636/A/B/C** - Updating the parameters for the NTS Optional Commodity Charge.

The Workgroup report for both the original and Alternative proposals has been completed and submitted to the April Panel, who will determine if it can be issued for consultation or referred back to workgroup for further assessment.

UIG Workgroup Headlines

- 0631R Review of NDM algorithm post-Nexus. A meeting was held on the same day as Modification 0644 (20 March 2018) and concentrated on the completition of the Request Workgroup Report. The review has raised awareness of UIG issues but the workgroup has not identified any specific improvements that should be progressed.
- **0644** Improvements to nomination and reconciliation through the introduction of new EUC bands and improvements in the CWV. The last meeting on the 20 March 2018 reviewed further analysis for the 3 key areas of the Modification. A ROM has been requested to determine wether the new EUC bands could be implemented for October 2018.

Demand Estimation Sub-Committee (DESC) www.gasgovernance.co.uk/desc

 There were no DESC meetings held during March. The next meeting (DESC TWG) is scheduled for 24 April 2018 to confirm the modelling runs to take forward based on aggregations/WAR band definitions.

Performance Assurance Committee (PAC) www.gasgovernance.co.uk/PAC

- PAC held a meeting 10 April 2018.
- The Performance Assurance Committee (PAC) agreed the PAC financial year 2018/19
 project plan that was presented by the Performance Assurance Framework Administrator
 (PAFA);
- Xoserve presented Post Nexus meter read performance analysis across Product Classes and highlighted the guidance provided to Shippers on this issue;
- The PAC discussed the Daily Metered (DM) read submission performance for Product Classes 2 & 3 along with the issue of delays in DM consumption adjustment;
- Conversations were had by PAC around incentivisation of positive performance in the industry and challenges to be addressed for an effective process to be in place;
- The PAC discussed industry performance on lack of transfer read submission and resulting issue of AQs of 1;
- The PAFA presented the three finalised PARR reports with analysis on trends:
- The PAC looked into AQ reports as a reporting area not covered by MOD520A reporting and will consider raising a Modification next month to implement this reporting;
- The PAC to introduce a Smart Meter agenda item for future meetings to discuss smart meter related issues e.g. Smart meter exchanges and read submission statistics;
- The PAFA to continue to develop the PRIDe performance assurance approach to provide a low level summary of a toolset for the PAC to consider, and
- The next face to face meeting will take place on 08 May 2018
